

The programme was a huge success and people from all walks such as industry experts, management, admin team, faculty and finally the students went out with a sense of gratitude and satisfaction.





Mr. Siva Kumar president ICTACT Tamilnadu in his address urged the students to decide their future for themselves by narrating his experience in becoming an entrepreneur and an employee and back as an entrepreneur again. He explained that the students should have the real industry experience to know the expectations and for which they have to strive hard. He also insisted upon being open about their opinions and answers. He cited his experience abroad while attending an interview. As an appreciation for the efforts of DRMCET, Mr. Sivakumar, president ICTACT Tamilnadu presented a certificate of Privileged Associate Membership for MCET in ICTACT to our Secretary.

He elaborated on India's aspirations to become a global competitor and requested the students to become a worthy workforce to meet this need. He told that the students need life long skill up gradation, proper aptitude and attitude to reach the altitude that they are aiming for. He recommended few points to the students to excel in their chosen careers, such as their ability to choose an apt career, ability to understand and adopt to the emerging technologies and dynamics. He called the students to be better team players and keep abreast of the developing events in the world. The session for Placement - Core comprised of two sessions. The morning session was taken up by the three eminent speakers and Dr. S. Vijayarangan (Director Academic) was the moderator of the session. Director- AC introduced the three eminent speakers and short address on employment process in an organisation. He delineated that the three eminent industrial experts with us would guide us on the atmosphere on which the core branch students would face and requested the students to make use of the session to shape themselves according to the need of the hour. He insisted on the importance of adaptability to situation and emphasized that it is our ability that would decide the peak that we would reach, so it is important for the young budding engineers to worthy by building their capabilities.

The first session was handled by Mr. R. Venkatanarayanan, President- HR, IT & Education, Rane Group, Chennai. His talk covered clear and detailed information about the working conditions in the industries, especially, in Mechanical & Automobile industries where the students should adapt to the working atmosphere wherever they are and however it might be. If one's choice is to work in a Foundry, one may not be provided with air conditioned amenities because the temperature differences directly affect the manufacturing processes. Risks are everywhere and it is not possible to find a riskless job. Each individual is inflated with boundless talents and the path towards the career has to be chosen wisely and carefully. If one's passion is to enter into the manufacturing sector, a complete research has to be made not only about the designation but also about the companies or firms related to the manufacturing sector. Consequently, the criteria requirements by the companies have to be clearly understood and a sincere effort would make one an employee of that company. While one works for a company, he/she has to constantly learn and practice. People have to think of themselves as the owners of that company and give relentless service. There are gaps between the academic curriculum and the industrial technologies. One has to keep himself/herself updated about the current trends and has to undergo internship/in-plant-training to keep in touch with the industry expectations. Especially, the internship duration has to be lengthy enough, at least 3 months, because this would provide an opportunity to the individual to learn a lot about the company and the company will have time to judge the individual's potential. In this case, one has got a direct opportunity to get recruited in that com-



The second session sparkled with the thought provoking words of Mr G.R. Janarthanan, Executive Director, India Pistons, Chennai. He started his magnificent speech by saying that the completion of B.E degree is just a beginning in the process of learning. He quoted that "Learning never stops" and learning, not studying is more important in the current scenario. He elucidated the developments and changes that happened over a long period of time in the industrial world. He said that expectations from customers are changing everyday due to the economic growth and the need for manufacturing sector to provide superior products has become the need of the hour. He narrated the manufacturing process of Pistons from the day he joined till today. He instructed everyone to learn every day about the development happening in the real world. He said new employees may face difficulties in the initial period but the company and the people are ready to accept them and make them comfortable. One important suggestion he made was that the budding engineers when employed must understand their jobs as well as their customers' requirements and quality requirements. It's important for employees to know about agreement of inspection and added that it's important to understand the team members because the real task lies in getting the work done rather than doing it by oneself. He emphasized on 5 principles namely, Delivery, Quality, Cost, Safety, and Morality. He enumerated the importance of environment and said that it's important to ensure that the production shouldn't affect the environment and should be pollution free. He also added that as young citizens of the country, it's the duty of all the Engineers to take care of proper utilization of resources and wealth like Power, water and all forms of energy.



Er. Mr. A. Sudhahar, Proprietor, Dimensions, Coimbatore started his speech with how one could plan their career. He said that one's career must be unique and added that the future changes, as one gains experience. He mentioned the word juxtaposition, meaning where you want to be and where you ought to be, and if these match, then the work of career planning is done. He also mentioned about the four main things which the industries expect from a fresher such as Energy, and Synergy. Interests cannot become a career but only passion towards something becomes our career. He also said that a best employee must be a potential entrepreneur. He stressed on learning at an initial stage and implementing them. He requested the students not to wait for the ideal moment and insisted them to learn the path as they travel in the industry. He called all the students to evaluate their strengths and weaknesses as they progress.



Then, the dais was left open for Mr.Visweshwaran Jagadeesan, Academic Technical Consultant of National Instruments. He began his speech with a clear definition of engineering. According to him, engineering is the application of science. He insisted that, students must apply their knowledge they have gained in the form of projects, prototypes, etc. He illustrated on how engineering had driven young minds to solve real-time problems in the society through real time analogies.



And finally, Mr. Nuthan Kumar, Senior Physical Design Engineer, Intel Technologies highlighted the importance of soft skills in professional career development. He brought light to the fact that soft skills cannot be attained through any kind of special trainings but can be achieved only by means of incessant practice. He also stressed on the fact that communication has a vital role to play in any industry. He also shared his work experience at Intel which was very interesting to listen. Thus the speakers delivered their valuable views on how to succeed in one's life, no matter on which path he/she goes, either be it an IT or core industry.



Mr.R.Karthigeyan from Lenovo, Pondicherry, was the first speaker. He delivered his ideas on career planning, team work and industrial expectations in a clear way. He gave away the words of reality that one must be unique in order to enrich and excel in his career; being unique from amongst 5 lakhs of freshly graduated engineers is a cumbersome task, but when one comes out of his comfort zone and sees the reality he would no longer remain dormant. He also briefed about the importance of communication skills, self-recognition and the ability to adapt to change. The students were motivated to give out 100% of their focus and concentration on any work they do and given a chance, success would not be far than a hands reach. Thus at the end of his speech, the students were eager to listen what other speakers were about to tell.

Mr.Divayashun Verma, Head, VR Development, Ericson shared his insights on how to face an HR interview. He embarked his speech by asking "what is this?" by showing his mobile to the students. Most common answer came from the students' side, saying it as mobile. He then continued by saying that engineers must explain contents in detail. So whatever question is put forth to an engineer, he/she must be clear and confident enough to explain it with clarity. He also insisted that being strong in the fundamental theories and being passionate to learn new stuff will aid to acquire a job faster than the people who are weaker in fundamentals. He made it comprehensible that a company would expect a smart candidate with strong fundamentals and the one who could work in a team with harmony. He bolstered on the importance of teamwork and taking responsibility of one's actions.

To take a break from the monotony of employment, he started a company when he was 32. After failing in his first venture, he went out to the market to be employed again. The session was much awaited by the students as they were all preparing to clarify their doubts from the speakers. Students gained hope and confidence from the interaction and positive speeches. The session put the students at ease and would help them stay positive, work energetically and climb the career ladder successfullyThe room was full of smileys as the students felt that the purpose of organising such an interaction session with the industry expectations, life style and the need for constantly updating their technical and communication expertise.

Dr.D.J.E. Ravithilagan's speech was realistic and motivational to the students. He started his speech by differentiating the generations of people. He clearly stated about the Talent of the young generation, the opportunities available and the challenges faced by the young generation. He stated about the demand for quality people in the job market. He quoted that A.R.Rahman is inspiring millions of people through his hard work. He spoke on how one should focus on his/her career and stated that "Distractions are more these days but we should focus on what we do". He concluded his speech by saying "Practice makes a man perfect".

Mr. Moorthy Duvvuri brought out the importance of confidence while attending the interview. He further added that in addition to technical skills, communication skills play a major role during the interview. He highlighted that lot of potential is hidden within the youngsters. He quoted a real time example of how an individual's confidence plays a major part than one's skills set. He reminded the gathering about the importance of self and made a note that even God will not help any individual directly.





Mr. Gokul Visweswaran commenced his speech with an example of "Best apple is always known in trees". He discriminated between practical and theoretical knowledge and insisted that motivation and focus are needed to achieve success. 



"FAILURE DEFEATS LOSERS BUT INSPIRES WINNERS"

Some people might have thought why should we bother about them? But our college is one such that it aims at a hundred percent support to all of its students and not some of its students. Thus born a motivational session for people who were not serious about what they were doing for some reason. It's not a finding fault session but finding what those students have in mind and fine tune them to achieve whatever they want to achieve. Of course, Mr. Sivakumar Palaniappan, founder, Mastering Mind Academy was the choice for resource person and he had never failed the students and our expectations because he is a known face to the campus and the students.

It was a session that made the students come out of their indifferent mind-sets to a more open platform where they were able to discuss whatever they had in their minds. Few were blaming their parents, few were blaming their friends, few others were blaming the educational system and few even blamed themselves for not being able to focus. There were other issues as well like not able to focus, fear of failure, fear of the arrear papers etc.

Mr. Sivakumar Palaniappan might not have offered a panacea for all their problems but his success lied in making the students comfortable in the first session and making them talk about their failures openly. He was one such person who always encouraged the students to embrace their abilities and fine moments that will move them forward. He made them feel very special in a way that they started feeling one with him. He brought out his failures in the subjects while he was studying and the importance of being friendly with the faculty members to get better results. He requested them to focus on getting help from faculty, friends and the management in terms of studies and studies related areas without any hesitation. He reminded them of the following quote.

"FAILURE IS THE PROOF THAT YOU TRIED. NOW GO TRY AGAIN"

He had a question answer session in the afternoon where he clarified the doubts and suggested remedial measures. Few statements that the students raised such as, "Parents are pushing us hard to score more marks" "Teachers respect only students who score more marks" "Teachers don't respect our skills" etc. reflected the contemporary education system's flaws and the teachers' inability to help the students who are struggling. Mr. Sivakumar Planiappan reiterated that scoring marks without gaining any practical exposure may not be the end of the world. Scoring marks may get you a job but to sustain in a job or to become an entrepreneur one needs to focus on practical learning. He also reminded the students that although practical exposure is good, a need for a degree during these days is really essential, and so urged them to focus on the task at hand and complete their degree successfully without worrying much about marks.

At the end of the session students walked with a sense of gratitude for the trainer, management and their parents and a resolution that they would come out in flying colours. Mr. Sivakumar Palaniappan is not a stage person but an audience person who walks down to the students and sit and talk with them. This made all the different.
