High Court Judge, Chennai

Justice R. Mahadevan was born on 10.06.1963 at Chennai. He had his schooling at Nehru Government Higher Secondary School, Nanganallur and graduated from A.M.Jain College, Meenambakkam. Attracted towards literature from very young age, he actively participated in various literary meetings during his school days and won several accolades. He was the vice-chairman of the A.M.Jain college students Union.

After obtaining law degree at Madras Law College, he started his practice in civil, criminal and writ sides with specialization in Indirect taxes, Customs and Central Excise matters.

He served as an Additional Government Pleader (Taxes) for the Tamil Nadu Government, as Additional Central Government Standing Counsel and Senior Panel Counsel for the Government of India at Madras High Court. He has conducted more than 9000 cases out of which more than 400 cases have been reported in journals. He is also a well known personality in the literary field. His Father Mr. M A Ranganathan is a renowned Tamil Writer. Justice R. Mahadevan was elevated as the Judge of Madras High Court in 2013.
