

Now, the result of automation has led to layoffs in many industries, especially in the IT industry as most of the operations and processes have been automated. Cognizant is all set to cut at least 6,000 jobs this year, which represents 2.3% of its total workforce, as it struggles with the growth in the IT environment that is fast shifting towards new digital services and also due to the impact of automation on lower-end IT jobs (programming and lack of skills). The layoff will also include non-performing employees. These employees include those who are not updated with the recent elevation in technology and who have low-level implementation skills with whatever they had learned from primary to Higher education.

Cisco has announced that it will lay off 7% of its global workforce in 2017, while IBM has announced 5000 job cuts, both with plans to reinvest money in priority areas such as internet of things and cloud computing. Microsoft, on the other hand has decided to cut over 2800 jobs this year as it plans to wind up its smartphone business.



In future, the key to layoff will rest in the hands of higher educational Institutions where students will be introduced to Advanced technology concepts in their curriculum. Reframing the curriculum with more practical learning and imparting skill-based learning from institution's end and more self-learning from the students' end might solve this issue. HYDROCARBON PROJECT A DEVIL IN DISGUISE AND A SILENT KILLER OF AGRICULTURE

METHANE -The chemical compound with formula CH4. This statement not only refers its address but also its nature of combustion. We are in the modern world where the population is high so the demand is also high. We need huge amount of energy, food and shelter. Since we are running out of non-renewable resources, we have to use an alternate source of energy. A project named "HYDROCARBON EXTRACT" is initiated by the government as an alternate way for producing electricity.

Generally, Methane is present in between the layers of coal and rocks which are present below the underground water. "Hydrocarbon fracturing" is the method of extracting methane from the underground. The extraction and manufacturing process demands investment. Nearly, Rs.5000 crores of rupees and probably more than that is invested for the methane extraction. The extraction is done by drilling well to a depth of 6000 feet vertically and several meters horizontally.

HYDROCARBON PROJECT

Once the wells are drilled, a chemical composition of 635 chemicals are pumped into the wells and this will break the rocks present underground. The broken rocks will release the methane gas from the soil and rocks and pipes are sent into the underground soil to absorb the methane gas. Methane gas is highly combustible and injurious to health. Several complications such as breathing and water pollution will be the aftermath faced by the people. In fact, the effects are unbelievable it might slightly improve the economy but on the other hand, it would entirely destroy our agricultural lands.





"Tanjore," an area located in the Kauveri delta is called the "Rice bowl of India". 80% of the people living there are farmers and agriculture based families. The soil present there suits only agriculture and it is famous for its wealth. Tamilnadu Government gave opportunity to the private multinational companies to introduce hydrocarbon project in "NEDUVA-SAL" of Pudukkottai district. This will greatly affect the farmers and as a result of this project nearly 12 farmers had committed suicide in a time interval of 10 days. Nearly 30000-60000 sq.kms lands are taken for this project and generally, this project will increase the electricity production. It would also bring about a large amount of profit to the country.

HYDROCARBON PROJECT

Methane can be extracted even in the waste land but the question is "Why the companies are eager to extract it from the agricultural land?" The MNC that has undertaken this project has planned to drill 2000 wells for the extraction. At an average, a single well requires 8 crores and 66 lakhs liters of water. So as a result, a large amount of water is needed to extract methane from 2000 wells. This large amount of water is planned to be taken from the Cauvery River. So the people living there will be forced to face a severe drought in the nearest future. Once methane is extracted the soil will lose its texture and its essential components and the farm lands will become waste lands.

Nearly 8,00,000 lorries of sand is required for this project, which will lead to the complete eradication of soil ecosystem. If methane enters the water table, it will completely immerse in the underground water. This will change the nature of the water by its burning capacity. Nearly, 635 CANCER inducing chemicals will be pumped to the wells to extract methane which will ultimately result in the reduction of the water quality.

Nearly 1,64,819 acres of land is chosen for this project all over Tanjore and Nagapattinam districts. Agricultural areas like Tanjore will become a desert as soon as the project is implemented. Once this happens, the land will remain infertile. So, once again people have to give their voice against THE SOCIAL CRU-ELTY realizing the fact that India is an agri based country and by killing farmers and farming, we are not going to achieve anything.


MY QUEST A SEARCH TO FIND THE PURPOSE OF MY EXISTENCE
