# EXPRESSWAY – A BOON OR BANE?

This article analysis different views of people in all the departments about the Salem-Chennai expressway dispute and provides a neutral conclusion for the dilemma which is, whether to consider the perspective of environmentalists or to accept the justification of our government. At present, it takes five hours and 45 minutes to travel from Salem to Chennai via Viluppuram. But the estimated time for the proposed expressway, would reduce the time to three hours. However, some say that the estimated time is not true. Among the modes of transportation, roadways are more preferable as it is the cheapest mode and we can travel to long distances by road. So, all the foreign investors consider expressway as an important profiting segment. Our government insists that this project would mainly improve the ratio of Indian land area to the expressway as it is less in India compared to other countries.



If the ratio becomes moderate, then the foreign investment might increase in our country. In 2011, NHAI (National Highways Authority of India) introduced a project called, “Bharathmala Yojana” which seeks to improve the standards of road

transport by 2022. The new expressway passes through Kancheepuram (59 km) Salem (38.3 km), Thiruvannamalai (122 km), Krishnagiri (2 km) and Dharmapuri (53 km). The forest department has stated in their official website that the proposed highway would pass through five forest reserves such as Nambedu, Aliyamangalam, Anandhavadi, Ravandhavadi and Chengam.





# EXPRESSWAY – A BOON OR BANE?

Mountains, ponds, rivers, lakes, wells, Malgova mango forests, agricultural lands, houses, schools etc. will also be affected. Recent arrests of Environmentalist Piyush Manush, actor Mansoor Ali Khan, and student activist Valarmathi show the differences of opinion between people and the government. They were held with the reason that they instigated people against the government but in reality they are the real saviours who tried to stand for the nature. Eight mountain ranges such as, Theertha malai, Kavuthi malai, Jarugu malai, Vedyapan malai, Javaadhumalai, Kalrayan malai and Sheraron malai would be affected. Though our Chief Minister has promised that the roads will be constructed with tunnels and the mountains will not be destroyed, the actual fact is that nothing can be done without damaging nature.



The ten thousand crore project was started mainly to encourage the Japanese and Korean investors and so, there is a chance that this might lead us back to someone else' control. The advantage of this road is that it would save time. The government says that they will give compensation not only for the land but also for houses, cattle, trees, agricultural lands, wells etc. Salem district collector has assured that skill based training will be provided to the farmers to improve their livelihood and a rehabilitation program will be undertaken.

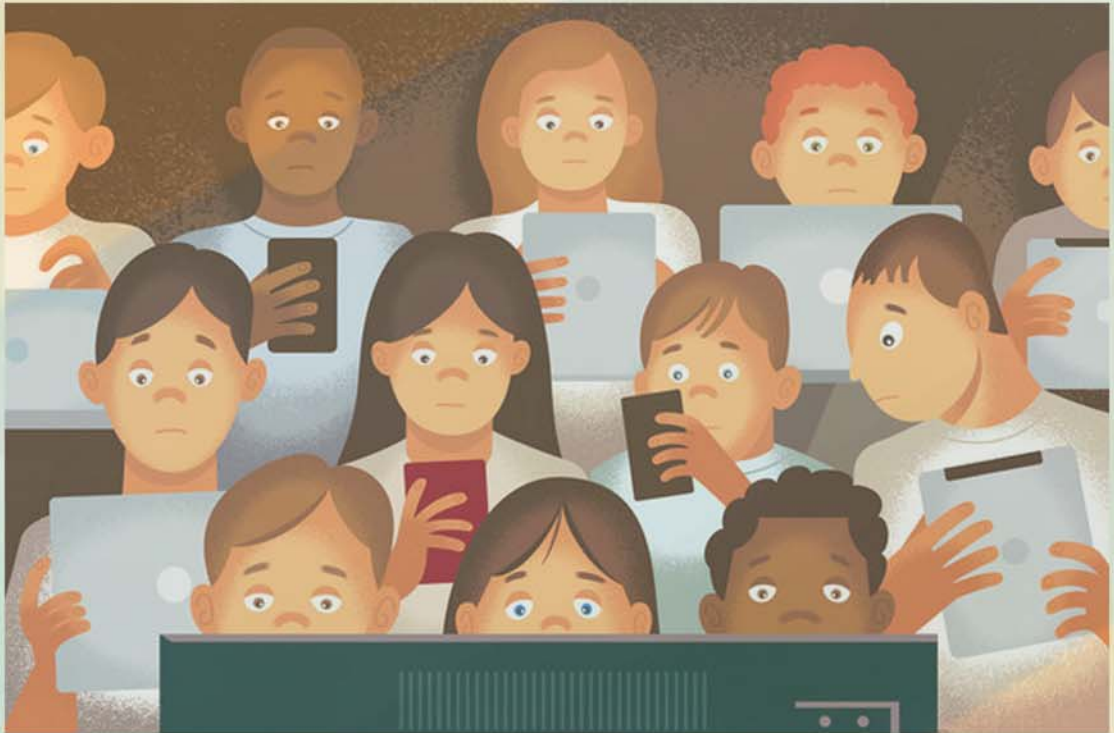

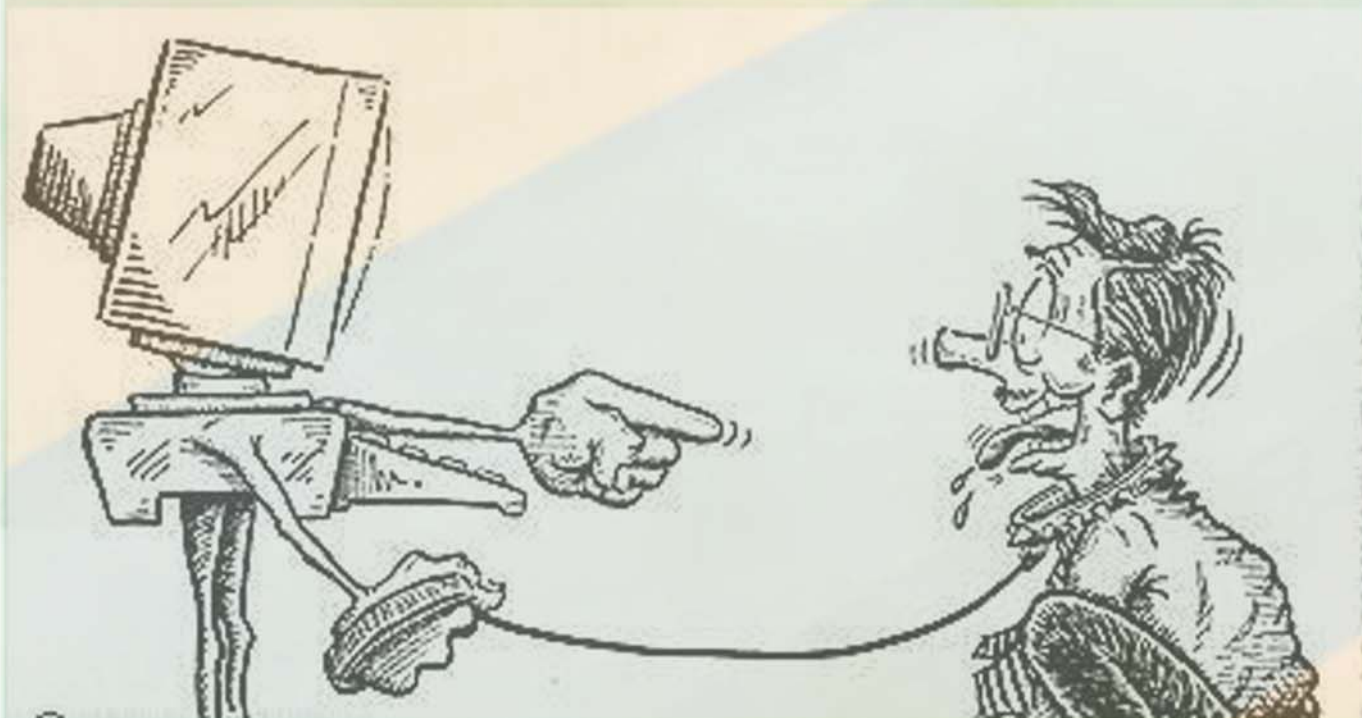

## GRADING SYSTEM IS EFFECTIVE IN COLLEGE

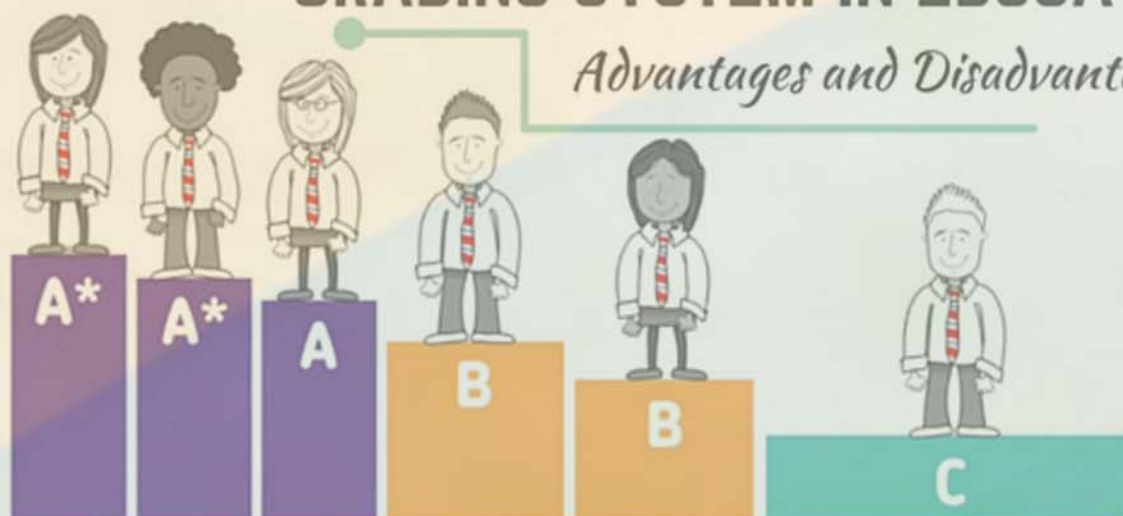

#### *Advantages and Disadvantages*

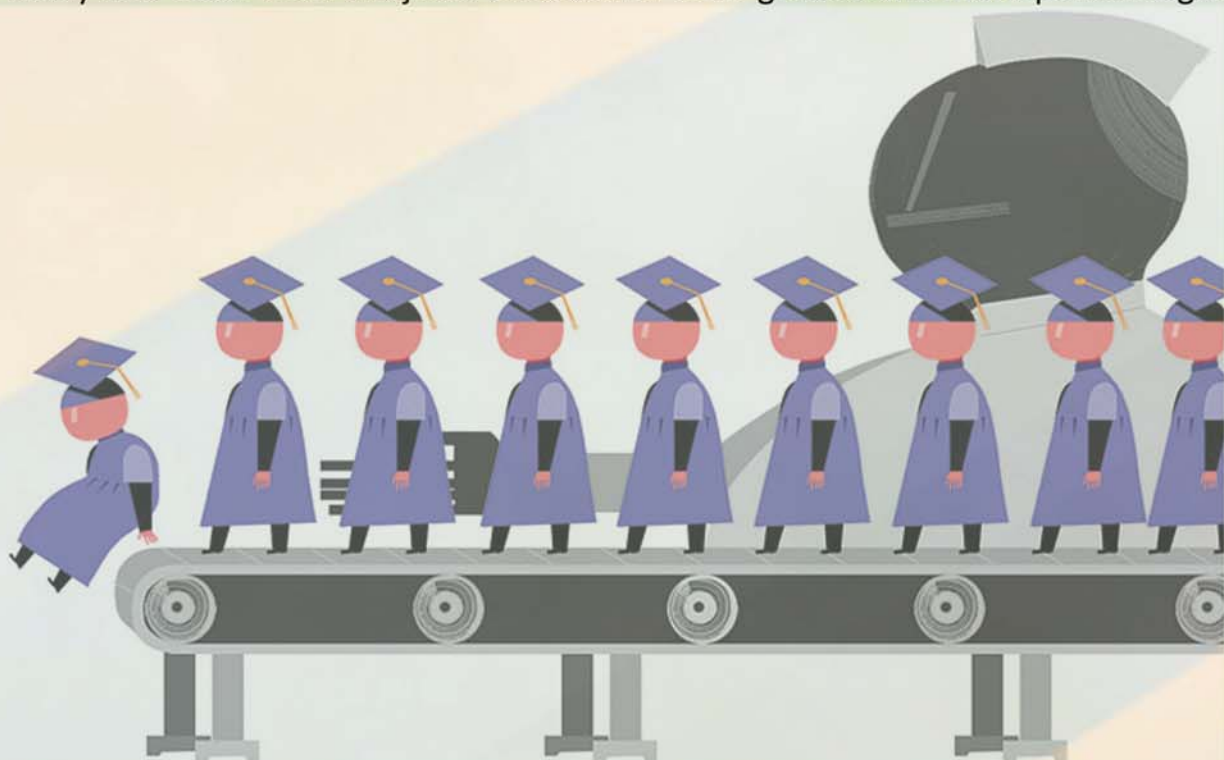
