## NIA EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS' CAMPUS DAY AND AWARDS DAY CELEBRATIONS



He congratulated and thanked all the alumni who contributed to the endowment.


He insisted on the importance of moving forward from here by insisting the alumni to make the bond with the mother institution stronger


