

Popular nonverbal mistakes made during job interviews

- 21% Touching face and playing with hair
- 47% Having no information or knowledge about the company job seeker applying to
- Avoiding making an eye contact 67%
- Sullen face, no smile 38%
- Wrong posture 33%
- Crossing arms on the chest 21%
- 9% Too intensive hand gestures
