Governing Council

Academic Council

Board of Studies

The Board of Studies is the basic constituent of the academic system of the college. Its functions will include framing the syllabi for various courses, reviewing and updating syllabi from time to time, introducing new courses of study, determining details of continuous assessment.

Finance committee

The Finance Committee advises the Governing Council on financial matters. It shall prepare income and expenditure statements of the college in the prescribed format for fixation of tuition and others fees of the college. The Finance Committee will be an advisory body to the Governing Council.

a. Interaction meeting:

Meetings are periodically organized with students and students' representatives by the Secretary, Principal, HoDs', Head of sections and other coordinators. During such meetings feedback on specific agenda as well as other aspects including governance and faculty performance are collected. Actions as required are initiated based on feedback.

b. Class committee meeting:

Class committee meetings are conducted thrice in every semester with four student representatives and all faculty members handling classes to discuss various aspects of teaching learning. A senior faculty acting as the convener for collecting the feedback on various aspects including governance and faculty performance. The convener communicates the minutes of meeting to the PC and HoD along with requests for actions if any. Actions as required are initiated based on the minutes.

c. Course committee meeting:

Course committee meetings are conducted in every semester for each section, the meeting was convened by the course coordinator along with respective course handling faculty members and students. The Course coordinator collects feedback on various aspects including syllabus coverage, content delivered by the faculty, Assignment submitted by students, Tutorial problems solved by students, Students attendance and also discussing about problems faced by students with respect to Academic related activities.

The convener communicates the minutes of meeting to the PC and HoD along with request for actions if any. Actions as required are initiated based on the minutes.

d. Student's Guild of Services (SGS):

Student's guild of services periodically conducts meetings of general body which consists of all student representatives, office bearers of association, clubs and SGS members. SGS collects feedback on various aspects including governance and faculty performance. SGS communicates proceedings to the Principal and Secretary based on the collected feedback for actions.

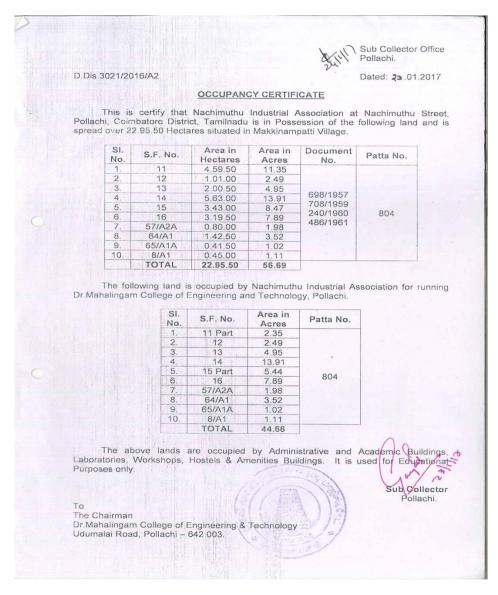


