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
Introduction to NIA Diamond Jubilee Celebration



NIA Educational Institutions was the dream of Thiru. P. Nachimuthu Gounder, which was later fulfilled by his son Arutchelvar. Dr. N. Mahalingam in 1957 with a vision to provide quality technical education to the rural population in and around Pollachi. Nachimuthu Polytechnic College is the brain child of Amarar Thiru. P. Nachimuthu which stands tall as the mother institution to various other institutions that were started in this campus and moved to other parts of Tamilnadu. NIA has crossed many milestones and expanded its horizons to Nursery school, Primary school, Middle School, High School, Hr. Sec. School, Agriculture and Engineering education under the stewardship and able leadership of Dr. M. Manickam and Correspondent Mr. M. Hari Hara Sudhan. It's an auspicious occasion as NIA Educational Institution completes its sixty years of educational service to the society.

Diamond Jubilee celebrations was held on 10th October 2018. Shri. M. Venkaiah Naidu, Honourable Vice-President of India was the chief guest of the occasion and Shri. S. P. Velumani, Honourable Minister for Municipal Administration, Rural Development and Implementation of Special Programmes felicitated the occasion. During this occasion, Arutchelvar Advanced Technology Centre and Mirakle Wellness Clinic were declared open and dedicated for the service by Shri. P. Venkaiah Naidu, Honourable Vice-President of India.

Few other special events were also organized such as Campus Day on 8th October 2018, NAAPA Alumni Meet on 9th October and Product exhibitions on all the four days by NPT Alumni. All these events marked as a result of the hard work of the management, admin team and employees of all the NIA Educational Institutions. The service of NIA educational Institutions will always be remembered and cherished among the people. It was an occasion that laid the foundation for many more humanitarian services that NIA Educational Institution would offer in the future.



The Diamond Jubilee celebration of NIA Educational Institutions was inaugurated on 5th September, 2017 at Nachimuthu Gounder Centenary Centre, NPTC-MCET Campus around 2.15 pm. To fulfill the visionary dream, to give the free gift of education to the economically downtrodden strata of society, Nachimuthu Polytechnic College was incepted by our founder Patron Dr. N. Mahalingam fondly called Arutchelvar in 1957 under the trust Nachimuthu Industrial Association [NIA]. Spearheading into its 60th Campus Day, NIA Institutions takes pride in commemorating the land marking moment of its inception which was started with barely 120 students under diploma stream which has now grown out to be a citadel of learning with over 25000 students from all across India.













The event commenced with a soulful prayer song followed by the welcome address. The welcome address was delivered by **Dr. M. Manickam**, Chairman, NIA Educational Institutions. In his address, Dr. M. Manickam recollected as to how the value and importance of service was inculcated by his late father. He encouraged the student community not to be bogged down by external impediments or duck under lame excuses in the true pursuit of one's dreams. He also urged the students to be fearless and face the problems of life as they impart true lessons of leadership in both personal and professional front.







The celebration was presided by **Dr. B. K. Krishnaraj Vanavarayar,** Chairman, Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan, Coimbatore.
In his speech he underscored the fact that the seed for service of the society through NIA educational empire was sown by Arutchelvar Ayya when he was 34 years old and the commitment is perpetuated by his illustrious son Dr. M. Manickam and now has been bequeathed to his grand son Shri. M. Hari Hara Sudhan.

He also reminisced the singular honour bestowed by our Ex. President Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam referring Arutchelvar as the business man and saint from whom one should learn the precepts of balanced life in one of his books.







Dr. Venu Srinivasan, Chairman and Managing Director, TVS Motor Company was the Chief Guest on this auspicious occasion. In his address, he paid his humble obeisance to Arutchelvar Ayya and lauded him to be the personification of simplicity, honesty and great vision. He also greeted the entire teaching fraternity for the steadfast commitments on 60th Anniversary which is incidentally also the Teacher's Day. In his thought provoking speech he accentuated the imperative for the students to be technically trained and to be industry ready to meet the ever-changing demands of industry.





He also stressed that the vocational training which is impetus for self-advancement and national growth has been made easy by the collaborative educational endeavours spawned between NIA and TVS which has benefitted tens and thousands of economically underprivileged students from the rural and semi-rural regions of Pollachi.





Thavathiru Kundrakudi Ponnambala Adigalar, Kundrakudi Adheenam, Kundrakudi unveiled the model image of Arutchelvar's Memorial and delivered the special address. In his vivacious speech, he reinstated that the parents are the first and best teacher from whom we learn moral values of life. He also draws a lively comparison between our Ex. President Dr.A.P.J. Abdul Kalam and Dr.Radhakrishnan irrespective of their designation as the Presidents of India came to be widely known as teachers who touched the hearts of millions of students. He further noted that Dr. Arutchelvar Ayya was Philanthropist who waged a war against poverty through his humanity, kindness and generosity.



TWO - DECADE CELEBRATION OF MCET



NIA Educational Institutions belong to Sakthi group, a 1.6 Billion US \$ Industrial Conglomerate and one of the fast growing business groups in India, with diversified businesses into auto-components, finance, textiles, dairy, renewable energy, etc. Sakthi Group of companies is justifiably proud of its meaningful journey in the field of education for the past sixty years. Arutchelvar Dr. N. Mahalingam, an industrialist, litterateur, a visionary thinker and a multi-faceted personality is the founder of these institutions. The underlying objective of the founder was to equip the predominantly agrarian youth of Pollachi region with industry skills to prepare them for the era of Indian industrialization.

It is a happy coincidence that the two-decade's celebrations of MCET falls during the Diamond Jubilee year of NIA. Celebrating this occasion will be a fitting tribute to Arutchelvar Dr. N. Mahalingam whose visionary efforts resulted in setting up MCET as an important constituent of NIA. To mark this occasion, a three day event was organized at MCET from 4th to 6th January 2018.





Diamond Jubilee Celebrations TWO - DECADE CELEBRATION OF MCET

DAY 1

First Day, an open house exhibition was organised which was witnessed by around 10,000 students from various schools of our locality. MCET also facilitated a rostrum for the school students to showcase their talents on this occasion.

DAY 2

Second day, in commemoration of the Diamond Jubilee Celebration of the campus and Two-Decade celebration of MCET, NIA Skill Foundation was launched with the following objectives.

- 1. To bring all skill building initiative inside the campus under one banner
- 2. To cater to the dire need of industries for role-ready technical workers
- 3. To contribute to the county's burgeoning need for skilled manpower

MCET has a meaningful and established relationship with quite a few globally reputed industries, which has resulted in setting up 15 Centres of Excellence (CoE) such as, TUV Rheinland Centre for Advanced Training (Welding and NDT), Bosch Rexroth Regional Centre of Competence, Siemens Centre for Digital Manufacturing, Mitsubishi Electric Centre for Factory Automation, etc.

While the CoE's offer advanced training, NIA Skill foundation offers vocational skill building programs in association with TNSDC catering to diverse crowd viz; ITI, Diploma and unemployed youths. To name a few, Suryamitra(NISE) program for training Solar PV Technicians, Welding Technicians' Training supported by Federal Bank's Federal Skill Academy, L&T Public Charity Trust, Nexora Academy and Gravitech. On the same day, around 100 prominent industry delegates were invited, including the existing collaborative partners and new companies from various domains to witness the event. This congregation was arranged for a meaningful interaction between industry and academia, intended to culminate into a win-win situation.

DAY 3

Third day, a mega alumni congregation was organized, inviting passed out graduates of past 16 years. The august presence of Government officials, celebrated industrialists and delegates from various walks of life enriched this historical event in the campus.



DAY 1 - OPEN HOUSE EXHIBITION (04.01.2018)

The two-decade celebrations of Dr. Mahalingam College of Engineering and Technology commenced at 10.30 am on 04-01-2018 with a prayer song. Dr. C. Ramasamy, Secretary, NIA Educational Institutions welcomed the gathering and briefed on the Diamond Jubilee Celebrations of NIA that includes 6 decades of Nachimuthu Polytechnic College, 2 Decades of Dr. Mahalingam College of Engineering and Technology and 1 decade celebration of Vanavarayar Institute of Agriculture.



He informed the gathering about various educational institutions under NIA that offer education from LKG till Ph.D. to the rural students. He proudly conveyed that 12000 students are studying across 4 campuses of NIA institutions with 1500 staff members. He expressed that Tamilnadu still stands tall amidst all the setbacks and challenges and youngsters in Tamil Nadu are in a better position when compared to other states. He insisted the students to work on their strengths and not on limitations and to utilise all the opportunities available in the campus. He was glad to share that the NAAC rating of Dr. Mahalingam College of Engineering and Technology which is 3.6/4 is one among the highest in Tamil Nadu.







Honourable Udumalai K. Radhakrishnan, Minister for Animal Husbandry inaugurated the School Competitions. He fondly remembered his experience as a student in NGM College while he was doing his B.Com and expressed his gratitude and happiness for inviting him. He proudly remembered the alumni who studied in NIA Educational Institutions and accomplished in their professions. He requested the students to utilize the Science Expo and benefit out of it. He also promised to do all possible help for the welfare of the rural students of this region.










He stated that in few years, the state syllabus will be better than the CBSE syllabus. He pointed out that NIA Educational institutions have always brought out disciplined students in the society. He requested the students to realize the importance of Education and put in their hundred percentage effort to excel in education and to seize future opportunities. He shared a few welfare schemes that the Government plans to launch to motivate and help the rural and Tamil medium students. He also stated that the Government is investing 100 crores in student exchange program across 12 countries around the world for 100 students every year.



Mr. R. Manivannan, Principal, NPTC delivered the vote of thanks and the function came to an end with the National Anthem.

It was a very memorable day to cherish as the school children displayed their projects and products to different school students and the distinguished guests. They also interacted with the team of ministers and visitors from different schools. Students from the visiting schools also participated in various competitions and exhibited their talents. DAY 2 - INDUSTRY CONCLAVE (05.01.2018)

An Industry conclave was organized on 5/01/2018 as part of the Two - Decade celebrations of MCET and Diamond Jubilee celebrations of NIA educational institutions. The function started at 10:00 a.m. with a prayer song.













Dr.C.Ramaswamy, Secretary, NIA welcomed the Industry delegates gathered from various parts of South India. He briefed on the Diamond Jubilee Celebrations of NIA. He also shared about the longstanding relationship with quite a few Industries in the areas of Joint Research, Consultancy, Student Projects, Faculty Development, Internship, etc.

He expressed his interest to deepen MCET's relationship with the Corporate World to bridge the gap between the Industry and Academia. He was open to forging new partnerships with the Industry to make the students Job ready from Day 1.







Dr.M.Manickam, Chairman, NIA Institutions delivered the presidential address. He started his speech by elaborating on the present educational system and industry trend. He explained how MCET has adopted industry attachment programmes where the curriculum is co-created in collaboration with the industry experts by incorporating all the required components of the present industry with a futuristic view. He informed the gathering that MCET on this occasion is adding one Skill Development Centre, Artisan Training Centre, Bosch Centre for Excellence, Agripreneur Programme and signing 5 MoUs with different companies in order to help the students and faculty members gain enough industry exposure.









Mr. M. Hari Hara Sudhan, Correspondent - NIA Educational Institutions delivered a brief note on NIA Skill Foundation. He wholeheartedly welcomed everyone and expressed his gratitude. He informed the gathering that the college has already got 15 Centres of Excellence that operate inside the campus including 7 global brands such as Bosch, Siemens, etc.





He conveyed that Industry 4.0 is already at the doorstep which will combine machine and human interaction and reduce human effort to a great extent. This new era in the industry has prompted the college to come up with the concept of NIA Skill Foundation which will bring all the training required by the Industries under one umbrella and provide futuristic training.



Mr. A.K.Tomer, Executive Director, Corporate Planning, Maruti Suzuki India inaugurated the NIA Skill Foundation and delivered his speech. He expressed his happiness for being part of this exhilarating experience. He started his speech with a quote of Prime Minister Shri. Narendra Modi that India should become the Skill Capital of the world. He displayed a graph which showed that only 10% of the workforce is really skilled.



He pointed out that 136 lakhs of skilled manpower will be required in the nearest future and building skill will make people employable. He requested everyone to be future role ready engineers by undertaking the necessary training. He pointed out that Indian and Japanese Governments have jointly established Japan India Institute for manufacturing (JIM), a skill building academy in Gujarat. He highlighted Industries' role in adapting colleges to impart industry training and upgrade the lab facilities. He also insisted on corporate social responsibility for adopting villages to provide better facilities to rural areas. He concluded his speech by quoting Mr.O.Suzuki, Chairman of Suzuki Motor Corporation, that Make in India will succeed only if India, develop skilled employees with quality consciousness.



Mr.R.Venkatnarayanan, HR-IT, Rane Group of Companies delivered the Two-Decade special address. He quoted Confucius by saying that if one wants to invest something on a 10 years return, one should plant trees but if one wants to invest on a 100 years return, one should invest in children's education.

He pointed out the efforts taken by MCET management to provide quality education and bring out skilled workforce. He stated that educational institutions play a major role in building the nation by developing responsible engineers.



He also insisted that the industry-institute partnership will help the country together by cooperating, collaborating and co-creating. He appreciated the efforts of MCET in taking this collaboration forward for the past 20 years. He requested the students to embrace technology by pointing out that industry 4.0 revolution of mechanization and automation that will have less human interface. He concluded his speech by quoting Confucius again that, to know what we know and what we do not know, that's true knowledge'



Dr. V. Kovaichelvan, Director- IQL TVS Motors launched the Agripreneur Programme. He started his speech by recalling the importance of starting a technical education in a rural area and his association with NIA. MR. THOMAS FUHRMAN

He listed few developments that happened in India in the past 20 years such as quality, automation, computer technology, reliability and a holistic approach due to the economic reforms and globalization. He pointed out the efforts of TVS, in developing role ready engineers in collaboration with the academic institutions such as NPT and MCET. He cited the idea of Agripreneur Programme and its development so far.

He pointed out the challenges faced by agriculture and farmers today such as, lack of rain, migration towards urban areas etc. He informed that 27 students have joined the first batch Diploma in Agripreneur programme and there are 10 modules equivalent to a professional MBA programme. This programme, he said, will mobilize people, give them confidence and self esteem. He appreciated the efforts of NIA institution and TVS Motor Company in this regard.

Mr.R. Ramesh, Executive Director, JANATICS INDIA PVT LTD inaugurated MCET-JANATICS Centre of excellence.



He fondly recalled his relationship with the campus as he is from the first batch of Kumaraguru College of Technology that was started here. He indicated that he got a strong foundation while he was studying here and that helped him contribute to the company effectively in providing solutions to different clients across the globe. 


